- Participants are required to bring all necessary stationary items, such as pens, pencils, erasers, rulers, and colouring materials, needed for their comic creation.
- Participants are not allowed to bring any pre-printed materials for their comic. All work must be created on-site during the competition.
- The judges' decision will be final and binding. Any objections or disputes will not be entertained.
